Therefore, Be It Resolved, that the Board establishes a reserve fund pursuant to Section 3651 of Education Law as authorized by the voters on May 17, 2016, to be known as the *Capital Reserve Fund*, to be used to pay the cost of any object or purpose for which bonds may be issued for renovations, improvements, and additions to District facilities:

Be It Further Resolved, that the Board hereby authorizes and directs the School District Treasurer to fund the reserve fund from any excess General Fund monies for the fiscal year ended June 30, 2016, in the maximum amount of \$500,000 and annually thereafter during the term of the reserve fund.
