Stan Kourofsky commented that some budgeted items were group together instead of separated out. It was the consensus of the Board that the materials and supplies and equipment line items be separated out and not grouped together.

Salary Freezes

Stan Kourofsky stated the Occupational Educational code line has increase. He commented that the district is sending students to BOCES before they are prepared. The district should have a standard on when a student is allowed to attend and policies should be established.

Karen Armstrong commented that in 2009 the district spent \$348,607.74 and budgeted for 2011 is \$1,026,610. She stated she supported occupational education and some kind of criteria should be established.

Richard LaVigne commented attendance should be look at and if someone cannot do the course, then they shouldn't attend.

Steve Trombley, President to the Board thanked the following staff who froze their salaries for the 2011-2012 school year.

Time 6:45 pm. The Board moved to the auditorium for the Public Forum on the 2011-2012 Proposed Budget.

Presentations

Public Comment

The Superintendent presented a draft 2011-2012 Proposed Budget. He commented on the budget planning challenges for the 2011-2012 budget including: state aid cuts, soaring heating fuel and diesel costs, CSE costs rising based on new enrollment, lost interest income, ERS & TRS employer portion rate increases, health insurance rate increase and foundation aid 'frozen'' again.

He stated the State Aid GAP elimination adjustment was in excess of \$2.4 million, three was a \$77,000 decrease in interest income, and a decrease of \$61,000 in PILOT revenue. The district applied \$3.574 million from the fund balance and assumed a total assessment increase of 3%.

Items which contributed to increase expenses was salaries, 3.5% increase in health premiums, 11.11% increase in the contribution rate for TRS (increase from 8.62%), 16% contribution rate increase for ERS (increase from 11.51%) and 30% average increase in heating fuel and diesel fuel. The total cost increase was \$3,161,177.

The Superintendent stated the district has the second highest enrollment in Clinton County. His PowerPoint indicated trends since 2007-2008 for State Aid & Tax Levy, Budget Expenditures, and Use of Fund Balance to offset Tax Levy. He showed School Comparisons within Clinton County on the Average Cost Per Student and the tax rates. The PowerPoint stated the tax rate in Beekmantown has fluctuated between 2001-2002 to 2010-2011.

The School Business Executive explained the Budget to Budget Revenues and the Budget to Budget Expenditures.

The Superintendent stated the proposed budget indicates the following reductions:

The budget totals \$38,721,107 which is an increase of 3.37% budget to budget. The tax rate for the 2010-2011 school year was \$15.46 per thousand and the proposed rate for the 2011-2012 school year is \$16.84 per thousand, which is an increase of \$1.38 per thousand. A question and answer period followed.
