# Elementary Grade Restructuring Meeting December 13, 2012 Superintendent's Office

# Minutes

Meeting was called to order at 4:34 p.m.

The committee discussed options for a strategic approach to begin the work toward achievement of 2013-2014 Board Goal:

"Research opportunities that could affect long term budget development including: a reorganization of the elementary schools as K-2 and 3-5 buildings"

As a result of discussions it was agreed that the general approach would involve a Steering Committee and several sub-committees. The major function of the Steering Committee is to collect and analyze data compiled by the sub committees on specific components associated with an elementary school reorganization, and to make eventual recommendations to the Board of Education. The major function of each sub-committee is to collect data associated with specific topics, develop and ask provocative guiding questions intended to provide a comprehensive assessment of both strengths and limitations of suggestions/findings based on the data, and develop a report to submit to the Steering Committee. These individual reports may/may not include specific recommendations.

The Committee then discussed identifying a few assumptions to help guide the work of all groups.

# Assumption #1

Current grade/site distributions in elementary schools will not allow for equitable services.

## Assumption #2

Resources available to provide equitable services/programs are projected to decrease at the state and/or local level.

## Assumption #3

There are financial, social, and educational values to be gained with compressed grade ranges within the elementary schools.

The Committee agreed to meet on a six week cycle, approximately. The sub-committees will meet on an as-needed basis.
